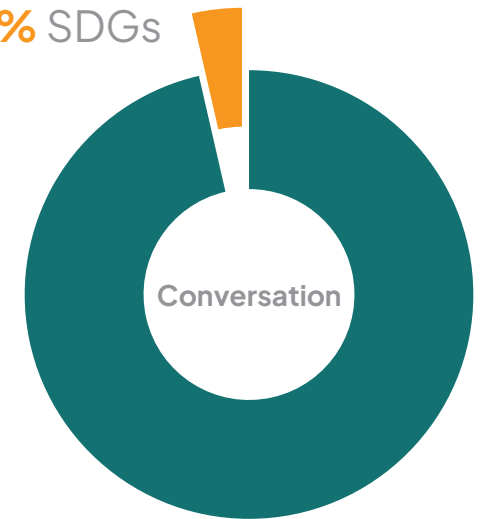

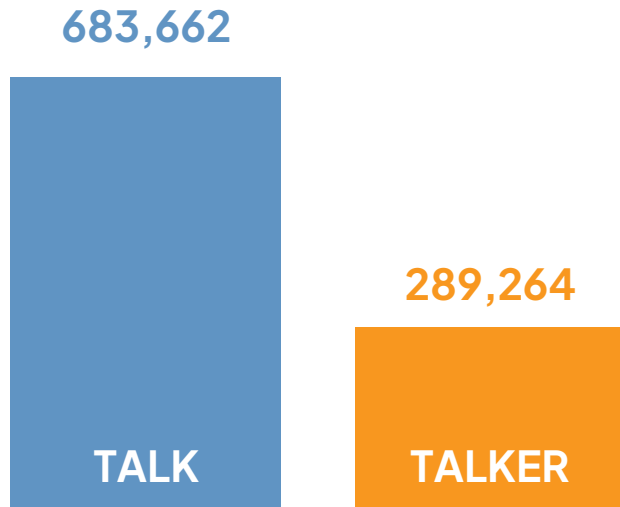

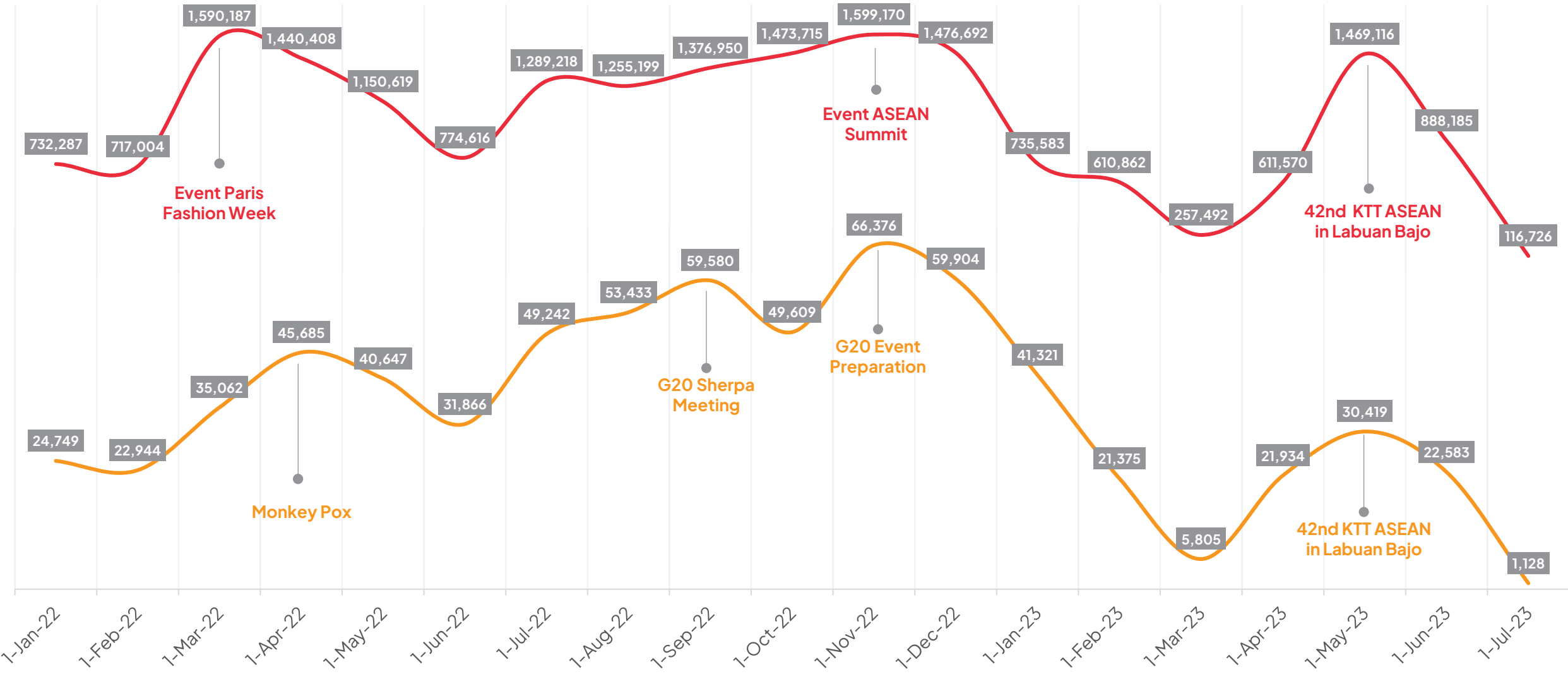

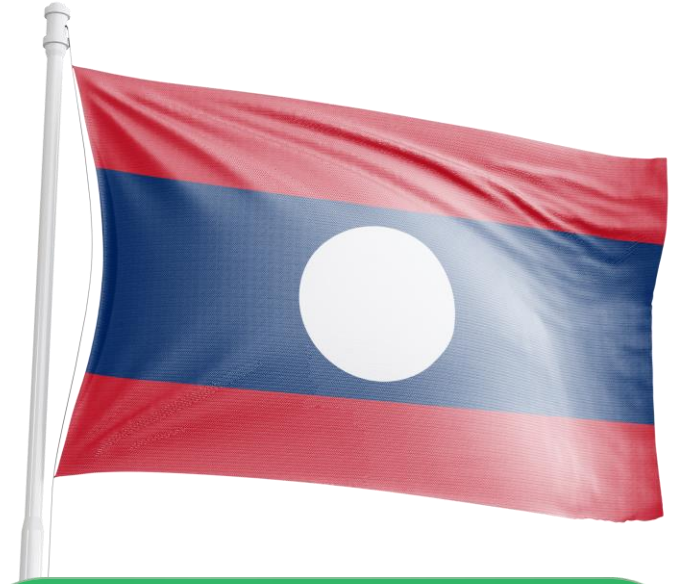

2.  All of the programs to boost SDGs topic are still initiated by government with 75% domination compare to others like companies, communities and NGOs.
3.  Some of the Youth program in SDGs are still not balanced. It's still dominated by Health sector and still low in Green Economy, Food Security and Future Work & Education
